

Centretown, Glebe, Old Ottawa South Accommodation Study

Questionnaire - October 2011 Public Consultation

Two draft Options have been identified for discussion and public consultation. Input on these options came from seven downtown schools (Cambridge, Centennial, Elgin Street, First Avenue, Glashan, Hopewell, and Mutchmor), and four community associations (Glebe Community Association, Old Ottawa South Community Association, Centretown Community Association and Dalhousie Community Association).

Option 1: to be implemented in Sept 2013

- Elgin, Centennial, and Cambridge schools remain unchanged.
- Mutchmor – Add 6 new classrooms to the school – school will offer English JK-6, Early French Immersion (EFI) JK-6 and the Early Congregated Gifted special education program grades 1-6.
- First Avenue – will offer Early French Immersion JK-6 (note: 37% of previous EFI catchment redirected to Mutchmor Public School)
- Hopewell – will have a reduced catchment area for grades 7 & 8 in English and EFI. Continues to offer English JK-8, EFI SK-8 and Middle French Immersion (MFI) 4-8.
- Glashan - expands its grade 7 & 8 English catchment area, adds an EFI 7 & 8 program for Elgin Street, Mutchmor and First Avenue schools, and keeps the Congregated Gifted, and MFI programs as they are.

Option 2: to be implemented in Sept 2013

- Elgin, Centennial and Cambridge schools remain unchanged.
- Mutchmor – Add 11 new classrooms to the school and offer EFI JK-6 for the entire Glebe area (ie. the program previously at First Avenue is moved to Mutchmor)
- First Avenue – offers English JK-6, MFI grades 4-6, and Early Congregated Gifted grade 1-6 (ie. programs previously offered at Mutchmor are moved to First Avenue school with the addition of MFI)
- Hopewell – will have a reduced catchment area for grades 7 & 8 in English and EFI and for its MFI 4-8 program. Continues to offer English JK-8, EFI SK-8 and Middle French Immersion (MFI) 4-8.
- Glashan will offer grades 7 & 8 for English, EFI, MFI and congregated gifted (note: all English, MFI and EFI from the Glebe area and Elgin Street school are redirected to Glashan)
