- Current students should bring a progress report from a LINC or ESL class
- If you are a new student or have been out of school for more than 1 year, you must be tested at the Language Assessment Centre at 240 Catherine St. Phone 613-238-5462 to book an appointment.

Eligibility for ESL/LINC

If you are a permanent resident, refugee claimant, or Canadian Citizen, you may be eligible to take free language classes. Please note: there is a \$10 material fee for ESL classes.

You are required to pay fees for the ESL program if you are in Canada with any of the following:

- Work Visa
- Student Visa
- Visitor Visa
- Diplomat
- Cleric

Free child care available for eligible families

- Bring child's immunization records
- Bring proof of income (ESL students only)
- Bring Ontario Works Case ID (if applicable)
