## SPECIALIST HIGH SKILLS MAJOR (SHSM) PROGRAMS

Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) diploma opportunities feature a combination of in-class and practical experiences, with the benefit of specialized facilities, equipment and teacher expertise. Students enrolled in SHSM Diploma opportunities may attend a host school for one semester and then return to their home school to complete diploma requirements. Please note the following:

- Students requesting a Specialist High Skills Major Diploma opportunity must review detailed program descriptions available on the web at [www.ocdsb.ca/shsm](http://www.ocdsb.ca/shsm).
- Admission to these opportunities is subject to space availability and the approval of both the home and host school principals.
- A host school may request an interview with the student prior to acceptance.
- Transportation is provided.
- Students enrolled in the Construction House Building Specialist Diploma opportunities, must be 16 years of age or older.
- Since the time of publication, other SHSM Diploma opportunities may have been approved, in addition to the ones listed below. Check with your Guidance counsellor for an up-to-date list of (SHSM) Specialist Diploma opportunities.

- Successful completion leads to a Specialist Diploma indicating the sector of Specialization (SHSM Seal) plus a program record transcript
