


SELECTING COURSES USING XELLO

The OCDSB uses an online tool called *Xello* for career exploration and course selection. This career exploration tool helps students build skills and knowledge to be future ready. The course selection tool helps students to select their high schools courses to achieve their pathway goals.

Follow the steps mentioned below to select your courses:

STEP 1: Log in to the *OCDSB Virtual Learning Environment*. Click in on the Login now button and use your Google credentials (*example@ocdsb.ca*) to login.



STEP 2: Click on "Grades 7-12"

STEP 5: Select courses under your grade level; start with English

STEP 6: For some courses, you will need to choose a level

- Principles of Mathematics, Grade 10
- Mathematics, Grade 10 (Locally-Developed)
- Mathematics for Work and Everyday Life, Grade 11

STEP 7: Once selected, click the "Add" button.



STEP 8: Advance the screen using the arrow and continue to add courses until you have selected all requirements for your grade; then select Done.
