International & Indigenous Languages Program (IILP)

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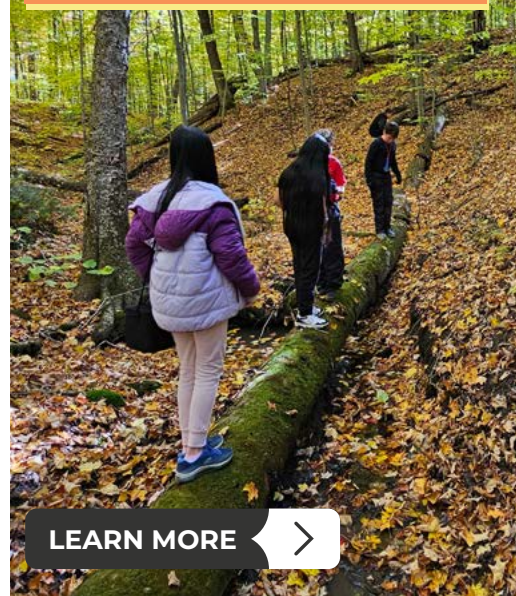

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LITERACY AND NUMERACY COMMUNITY SUPPORT PROGRAMS

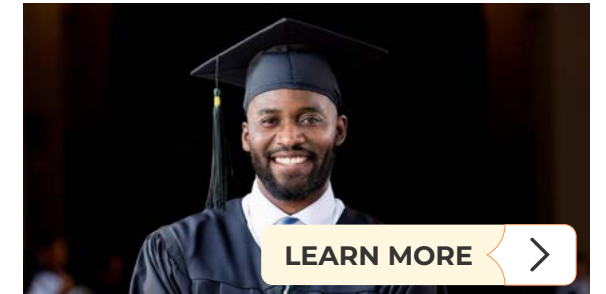

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LITERACY & BASIC SKILLS PROGRAM

SKILLS UPGRADING

The Skills Upgrading Program is for adults who have one of the following goals:

- Attending adult high school or college
- Finding a job
- Becoming more independent
- You need to have at least CLB 3 in English (Listening and Speaking). Reading, writing, math, or computer skills may be at a lower level.

ACADEMIC UPGRADING

The Academic Upgrading Program is for adults who want to:

- Improve reading, writing, communication, math, or computer skills
- Meet the admission requirements for high school, college, or other training programs

WORKPLACE PREPARATION

The Workplace Preparation Program offers training for jobs:

- Certificates for Employment
- Employment Preparation for Childcare Assistants
- Employment Preparation for Health Care Aide
- Employment Preparation for Student Support Worker

To join, you must be 18 years or older and have at least CLB 5 in English (listening, speaking, reading, and writing).
