



Litterless Lunch

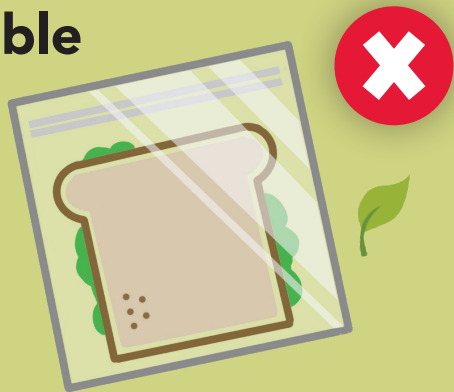
To reduce lunch waste, we ask that all leftover items be sent home with students for proper disposal through the City of Ottawa's residential waste program.

Why Go Litterless?

- REDUCES WASTE:** Less trash in our landfills.
- PROMOTES SUSTAINABILITY:** Teaches kids about environmental responsibility.
- SAVES MONEY:** Reusable items are cheaper in the long run.
- HELPS OUR SCHOOL:** Keeps school grounds clean.

Reduce Disposable Lunch Bags

Use a reusable lunch bag instead of disposable plastic bags or wrappers.



Reusable Lunch Boxes

Pack sandwiches, snacks, and leftovers in reusable containers.



Reusable Drink Bottles

Use a reusable water bottle or thermos instead of single-use juice boxes or cans.



Reduce Single-Use Packaging

Buy items in bulk and portion them in reusable containers.



Reusable Utensils

Include a set of reusable cutlery and a cloth napkin.



Composting

Bring a separate container for fruit peels and other compostable items to take home. Encourage kids to do this.



Recycling

Encourage kids to bring home recyclable food storage items like aluminum containers and foil.
